Most elders prefer to stay at home in order to save their limited stock of masks. A group of volunteers discovered that one elderly couple in their 90s visited the hospital without any mask, but fortunately, they were each given one by a kind nurse. Instead of disposing the used masks, they tried to dry them for reuse. After knowing their situation, the volunteers immediately gave them their own masks they had in their bags.

Let's show more concern and care to our elder neighbours as they may have difficulties finding the necessities.

We also shared the surgical masks with some home service centres. Without any mask, the frontline staff were having difficulties delivering meals to the elders. These masks solved their urgent needs.
