HOPE worldwide is grateful that we have received various donations including masks, alcohol-based hand sanitizer and other anti-epidemic materials since the outbreak of the disease. The supplies arrived in time to support the urgent needs of the elderly and low-income families living in Sham Shui Po and Kwai Tsing areas, as well as the elderly centers in various districts.

'Harmony Across Generations Center' provides activities, including cognitive training and dental care to meet their needs. Our volunteers are also making regular home visits for those with physical limitations.



We keep on distributing anti-epidemic supplies to more than 450 elderly members of the Harmony Across Generations Center.

## HOPE worldwide x Food Angel

Provide free meal to the grassroots in Shek Kip Mei District

Another good news is that we are now cooperating with Food Angel to deliver free meals for the low income families and the elderly living in Shek Kip Mei area. Food Angel provides 150 boxes of frozen meal to our Harmony Across Generations centre every week for distribution. The beneficiaries can enjoy the food by simply steaming it which is very convenient.



It is our first cooperation with Food Angel. We hope the free meal distribution services can further be extended to benefit more needy people.

# 80+20 Community Elderly Oral Health Program

We once heard from a volunteer that the wish of an elder he met was able to eat meat again. Many elderly people lack the knowledge of oral care leading to tooth loss that gradually affects their chewing ability. HOPE worldwide Dental Clinic launches the “80+20 Community Elderly Oral Health Program” sponsored by “Vera Ruttonjee Desai Charitable Fund” that aims at educating the elderly to pay more attention to their dental health and retain at least 20 healthy teeth at the age of 80.

We have cooperated with various elderly centers in Kowloon district since last year. We

arranged dentists to have oral examination for the elderly. If prescribed by the dentists, free dental scaling was offered to them at our clinics. More than 400 elderly people have been benefited under this program. Our dentists will continue visiting more elderly centers when the epidemic is gradually eased.
